## Outline:

Legislation Type Title [year] OJ L Issue/First Page, pinpoint (if necessary).

## Example:

Council Decision of 6 May 2021 appointing twelve members of the Management Board of the European Chemicals Agency 2021/C 185/02 [2021] OJ L 185/4.

This falls under **Section 2.6.1 EU legislation** of the OSCOLA guide, **so the reference goes in the footnotes NOT bibliography.**
