Example:

Council Recommendation of 12 March 2021 on Roma equality, inclusion and participation 2021/C 93/01 [2021] OJ L 93/1.

This falls under **Section 2.6.1 EU legislation** of the OSCOLA guide, **so the reference goes in the footnotes NOT bibliography.**
